

## GREENLAWN CEMETERY - Soldiers Circle (Section 15)

This circular section lies directly east after entering the Offnere Street gate. It includes only graves of United States Soldiers. There is one grave for Maria Jeffords Miles, an army nurse. The section is easily distinguished by the large statue of the Union Soldier. The inscriptions were copied by Julie Bowles, October, 1983.
