A Note From The Editor

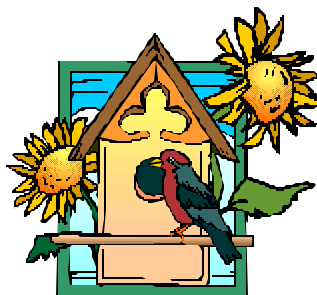
Hello Members,

**NARA PROPOSES PRICE HIKE**

The financially beleaguered National Archives and Records Administration (<http://archives.gov>) wants to raise its microfilm copying service—by a whole lot. According to the proposed rule in the Feb. 26 [Federal Register](#), complete Civil War pension files would jump from \$37 to \$125. Non-Civil War pension files older than 75 years would cost \$60. Military service files older than 75 years would cost \$25, as would passenger lists, census records and bounty land warrant applications files.

NARA says the fee hike—the first since 2000—is necessary to recover costs such as staff time, paper and postage associated with providing copies of records to the public. In 2006, the agency's costs for fixed-fee copying services (such as military pension files) were more than double the revenue received for them.

GENEALOGY WEEKEND

GENEALOGY WEEKEND

Greenup, Ky. - Anyone interested in researching their family tree will want to mark their calendar for the weekend of March 23-24. That's when the Kentucky State Parks and Kentucky Genealogical Society will hold a Genealogy Weekend at Greenbo Lake State Resort Park. Experts on genealogy will offer advice and tips on topics such as research methods, land grants, military records and publishing family histories.

"This is the first of a series of annual genealogical conferences sponsored by the Kentucky State Park system," said state parks Historian Ron Bryant. "We have genealogical experts in most fields of research. These men and women are known throughout the region as experts in genealogy."

The weekend will begin the evening of Friday, March 23, with registration, an "ask the experts" session and dinner. At 7:30 p.m., Kandi Atkinson of the Secretary of State's Office will discuss land grants and records followed at 9 p.m. by Ron Elliot, an author who will talk about publishing family histories. Saturday will feature Peggy Galloway of Danville, who will talk about "Family Skeletons and Their Place In Our Research," James Pilchard of the Kentucky State Archives, who will share his knowledge; and Chris Propes of Waveland Historic Site who will discuss researching family history through photographs.

Also speaking on Saturday will be Anne Pennington, president of the Kentucky Genealogical Society and Mike Watson, editor of Bluegrass Roots; and Walter Bowman of the Kentucky State Library and Archives will discuss World War I military research.

To register for the weekend, call the park. There is a \$5 fee that can be paid upon arrival. Greenbo is also offering one and two night packages that include lodging and meals that start at \$91.80 a person for one night and three meals.

Greenbo Lake State Resort Park in Greenup County has a lodge, Anglers' Cove Restaurant, gift shop and 23 miles of hiking trails.

Genograms . . . All In The Family, by Dorie Leathers

You know that your curly red hair came from your grandmother and your prominent nose from your father. These, however, are not the only things that you may have inherited from your family. Have you lost a family member to cancer or heart disease? Have any family members suffered from hypertension, diabetes or stroke? These, and many other medical conditions, have been shown to be passed down through family lines. Experts maintain that as many as one-third to one-half of all health conditions have a genetic component—and although many conditions have an environmental factor, there is a significant genetic link as well. A detailed analysis of your family medical history may well reveal hereditary conditions for which you, and other family members, may be at risk. And yet, how many genealogists have tapped into their research to create a family medical history—when the information is right there at our fingertips?

How useful are family medical histories? Quite simply, they help document familial patterns which may impact your health. Compiling your family medical history can help you and your doctor to identify these family patterns and use that information to assist with the following:

- ~deciding which medical tests to run and diagnosing a medical condition
- ~calculating your risk of certain diseases
- ~determining if you may benefit from preventive measures to lower your risk of a specific disease
- ~calculating your risk of passing certain conditions to your children
- ~identifying other family members who are at risk for developing certain diseases

Many people realize the importance of keeping a family health history record, but are at a loss as to how and where to begin. The best way to present this information to your doctor is in the form of a family health pedigree, called a genogram—a single paged graphic representation of family members and health conditions. Not only can the doctor see what familial health conditions are present, but also how closely the affected family members are/were to the patient and how these conditions are being transmitted from generation to generation.

Genealogists will immediately note the similarities of a genogram to a traditional pedigree chart, but there are also significant differences. In health pedigrees it is not necessary to list names, documenting three or four generations is sufficient; they extend horizontally as well as vertically, including siblings, cousins, aunts and uncles; and they use standardized symbols recognizable to health professionals to indicate the gender and relationship of each family member.

The standard set of symbols used in creating a genogram are:

- ~a square indicates a male ~a circle indicates a female ~an x indicates that person is deceased
- ~a horizontal solid line connecting two people shows a committed (married) connection
- ~a horizontal solid line which is slashed shows a divorce or non-committed relationship
- ~vertical solid lines indicate a biological connection ~vertical dashed lines indicate adoption or other relationships

Some of the medical conditions which you should consider documenting include:

alcoholism	birth defects	emphysema	high blood pressure	muscular dystrophy
arteriosclerosis	cancer (any kind)	epilepsy	kidney disease	stroke
arthritis	cystic fibrosis	heart disease	learning disabilities	tuberculosis
asthma	diabetes	hemophilia	mental illness	vision/hearing loss

The further back you go in your research, the more difficult it will become to identify a cause of death. Medical terminology has changed over the years and advances in medicine have placed doubt on some earlier diagnoses. If you have an ancestor who died of “domestic illness”, what exactly was the cause of their death? According to the archaic disease name sites, this could mean “mental breakdown, depression, Alzheimer’s, the effects of a stroke” - leaving you with any illness that kept this person housebound. Perhaps this is why genograms are usually limited to three or four generations!

Make a New Year’s resolution that you can actually keep. Dig into those records you have so painstakingly gathered and create a family genogram. Do it for yourself...do it for your children...do it for the health of it!!
