Ancestors living in past or present boundaries of Scioto County on or before December 31, 1830 are eligible for placement on the roster of Pioneers of Scioto County.

**Bylaws Revision:**

**ARTICLE IX - COMMITTEES**

The Chapter shall have committees charged with performing necessary functions of the Chapter. The Committee Chairs shall be appointed by the President with the approval of the Board. The chairs may choose other members to be on the committee.

The Chapter shall have the following Standing Committees whose responsibilities shall be detailed in the Standing Rules: Cemetery Committee, Membership Committee, Newsletter Committee, Publication Committee, Research Committee and Lineage Committee.

Special Committees may be appointed by the President to be approved by the Board in order to fulfill a specific function for a limited period of time.

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**SCCOGS Standing Rules**

**A - OFFICERS**

**President: The President shall call meetings of the Chapter and the Board, preside at Board meetings and regular business meetings, and appoint committee chairs. The President communicates, motivates and leads members to support the purposes of the society. The President shall be a member of OGS**

**Vice President: The Vice-President shall perform the duties of the President in the absence of the President. The Vice-President shall also serve as Program Chair to plan for six meetings (and venues), contacting speakers, verifying schedules, introducing and paying them, as well as providing program information to the Newsletter Editor and Publicity Chair in a timely manner.**

**Recording Secretary: The Recording Secretary shall attend meetings to record minutes of each meeting, and to read minutes of the previous meeting. She compiles minutes from year to year as a historical record of activities.**

**Corresponding Secretary: This Secretary shall handle the correspondence pertaining to the chapter. This includes: handling mail for P. O. Box 812, SCCOGS post office box, picking up mail at the post office, recording mail received In a Correspondence Log, distributing checks to the Treasurer, publication orders to the Publications Chair and research requests to the Research Committee. The corresponding Secretary also handles email sent to [sccogs@sccogs.com](mailto:sccogs@sccogs.com) and answers any mail that requires a return.**

**Treasurer:** The Treasurer shall receive dues and pay bills authorized and approved by the chapter, keeping accurate records of all income and expenditures in a format which can be audited in keeping with standard accounting practices. The Treasurer should pay bills as they are received, deposit checks in a timely manner, and make a report at each business meeting. The Treasurer figures/reports/pays sales tax to the Ohio Department of Taxation as required and files required annual forms to the IRS.

**Librarian:** The Librarian shall be responsible for the Chapter holdings at the Portsmouth Public Library. This includes, keeping materials arranged neatly and repaired, processing new additions for shelving and updating inventory as new materials are added.

**Historian:** The Historian shall keep a written or pictorial record of the activities of the society.

#### **C. STANDING COMMITTEES**

**Cemetery Committee:** The Cemetery committee takes responsibility for continued location and updating of inscriptions found in Scioto County cemeteries. They will compile information which the society may publish to be available for Scioto County research.

**Membership Committee:** The Membership Chair keeps records of paid membership in a 4x6 card file as well as on computer, updates the Newsletter Editor on new members and address changes, attends meetings to collect dues, and reaches out for ways to get new members.

**Newsletter Committee:** The Newsletter Committee is responsible for creating, editing and sending a bimonthly newsletter which contains Scioto County genealogical information and news for Chapter members. The committee helps find appropriate local information and articles for the editor. The committee handles sending the newsletter to members electronically, or printing and mailing the newsletter to members without computers.

**Publication Committee:** This committee keeps an inventory of Publications for Sale, fills orders for publications and mails them, keeps records of sales tax charges for the Treasurer, arranges for additional copies of publications as needed, and notifies the Webmaster and Newspaper Editor when there are changes in pricing or availability.

**Research Committee:** This committee responds to queries received for Scioto County lookups. They research at appropriate Court House offices and the Local History Department of the Portsmouth Public Library. They communicate in a professional manner with those who send queries and answer them in a timely manner.

**Lineage Committee:** This committee reviews applications for ancestor membership in Pioneers of Scioto Valley based on criteria established for membership. They charge a fee of \$15.00, and based on the review, give out a certificate to those accepted for membership.

### Did You Know?

**Scioto County** had a series of semi-pro football teams in the 1920s and 1930s, the most notable being the **Portsmouth Shoe-Steels**, whose roster included **player-coach Jim Thorpe**. From 1929 to 1933, Portsmouth was home to a professional football team, **The Portsmouth Spartans**. This team later became the **NFL franchise Detroit Lions** in 1934.
