May have fathered GEORGE THEODORE SHERMAN. His mother was Elizabeth Mummert (unwed) and gave birth to George T. Sherman in 1868. Elizabeth Mummert later married Henry Heck (from Germany) and had several children. One child was Chester Heck (married to Sarah Jane Wildason). George Theodore Sherman (1868 - 1947) married Johanna Lidina Wildason (born March 11, 1870 in York Co., PA and died Aug. 23, 1933 in Harford Co. MD). Sarah Jane and Johanna Lidina Wildason were sisters. Census - Jan. 6, 1920 in Bel Air, Harford Co., MD -- Lived on Medical Road on farm, rents the house. He is age 52 yrs old, born in PA in the 1920 census. His wife - Joanna L. was age 50 yrs. born in PA. They have three sons, two daughters Herman -age 22 yrs born in MD. Stouh - age 16 yrs., Alice age 12 yrs, Carrie, age 10 yrs. and Wilson Sherman -age 6 yrs old. The family ran a dairy farm in 3rd District, 2nd Prec. ED #92.
