“Need Help with Your Genealogy?”

The Collin County Genealogical Society will try to have one or more of its experienced researchers available on the first Tuesday night of each month from 7-9 p.m. to help answer your genealogical questions. A GLHTA staff member will always be available. The genealogy collection is open from 1 - 9 pm on Tuesdays.

Experienced researchers will be available to assist, answer questions, provide suggestions and help solve problems.

The GLHTA collection is primarily organized by:

- Passenger Lists and Immigrants by Country (“I”)
- Books on Military Service and Military Records (“M”)
- Family Genealogy and History books by Surname (“G”)
- International Books (by Country Code)
- United States Books in general
- Books on all States (by State Abbreviation) and then county specific books alphabetical within state (County names on the binder and that county’s books all shelved together!)
- Non-bound Periodicals
- Maps, Vertical File, (Local) Surname Files
- Microfiche and Microfilm
- Computers with access to Library databases (like Heritage Quest), internet, free Ancestry.com and Footnote.com data. Save data to your USB drive or print it to paper for ten cents a page. Bring your Plano library card or get a guest library card.

The microfilm collection includes federal census records from 1790-1930, newspapers (from Dallas, Garland, Fort Worth, McKinney, Plano and New York), Texas Tax Rolls, many rolls of Collin County specific information and miscellaneous non-census film on other states. Print your microfilm images to paper for ten cents a page or use the one PC hooked up to a microfilm machine to save images to a USB drive.

Bring your questions, brick walls, and information you have on each person being researched in written form. Include (1) name, (2) location of residence or event, (3) estimated time period.
