Family History Tips



File as you go to avoid hunting in the future - The short amount of time it takes to file a record copy or other document will be time well spent when you are looking for that document a few months or years down the road. Spending an entire afternoon searching through your stacks for something is not time well spent. You might also want to include the name of your file folder in your notes or sources when performing data entry. Research is not just names, dates & places - Questions for your research log can sometimes be personal questions you have on a certain ancestor. Make a chart for each ancestor with their name, birth, death, marriage, spouse. You might have a list of questions for example, Immigration, Occupation, Religion, Adoption, Military Service, Spoke Foreign Language, Family Stories about this Person. These questions could also add some color into your gathering of materials on your family as time goes by. After all genealogy is not just about birth, death and marriage.
