

Powhattan County Marriage Bonds, 1806-1819

Reel 39, counter #30-31. Marriage between James Criddle and Judith Fitzsimmons

Know all men by these presents that we James Criddle and Wm Maginnis are held and firmly bound unto Wm H. Cabell esquire governor and chief magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of one hundred and fifty dollars - To which payment well and truly to be made to the said governor and his successors we bind ourselves jointly and severally firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated this 5th day of May Anno Domini 1806.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas a license has this day issued for the intermarriage of James Criddle and Judith Fitzsimmons daughter of Judith Fitzsimmons of this County_____

now if there be no lawful cause to hinder or obstruct this said marriage then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.
