



Cremation entries in the database

To revise the terminology from Buried to Cremated as shown in the below example, click on the + symbol at the end of that row currently reading Buried. This will then change the wording to Cremated for that person only. Now proceed to make the entries as normal. In the location field enter information as you wish, NOTE:, it will go into the location master listing. So if you don't want that kind of information there, then leave that part open and enter it as an event.

If you have a situation where a person is both cremated, and buried, consider the below shown example. Again the + symbol was clicked and the wording revised. Next you may enter the location of where the cremains were inurned, a cemetery, or other location. (This location information again does to the master location listing.)
