

Thanks to Larry Dean for compiling this list of what can be expected of the Legacy Standard (free) edition and the functions it won't do. We discussed this at the June 4 meeting.,

With the STANDARD (free) Legacy edition, you can

enter data, including notes and source fields

view stored data in the family and pedigree formats

view stored data in the index format, but death dates and places are NOT displayed.

generate the following book reports: ancestors, descendants and descendant narrative,

view and print generated reports and save them to text and html files.

use tagging, but the standard edition has only 3 tagging levels instead of 9.

do LDS ordinance reports

save and back up family files.

import and export a GEDCOM.

generate the following reports: individual, family group, pedigree, descendant chart, ancestor chart, timeline, ancestor book, descendant book, descendant narrative book and lineage.

With the Legacy FREE edition, you can NOT do these things: (You must have to Deluxe Edition to do any of these things.)

view stored data in the chronology or descendant formats

use the forms center (to print blank forms)

use the event report

use the calendar creator

generate a potential problems report

create a family picture tree

limited use of the "research guidance" feature (like Gen Smarts) to search the internet for a

person in your database

generate the following book reports – Publishing Center, Multiple Lines of Descent

(Publishing center prepares consolidated book reports and creates an html document suitable for uploading to the internet).
