



**Klickitat County** was founded in 1859 from parts of Skamania and Walla Walla counties. It was named after the Klickitat Indian tribe and the word means "robber or thief." The county is located in the extreme south center of the state and is bounded on the south by the Columbia River.

Erastus Joslyn first settled the county in 1852. However, not until 1867 was an effective county government organized. Transportation played an important part in the county's history. An U.S. Army wagon road crossed the county in 1855, and later the Columbia Railway and Navigation Company's railroad and competing Columbia River steamboats provided a colorful chapter in its history. Today, Klickitat County bases its economy on food processing, agriculture and wood products.

NOTE: Immediately after creation, territorial legislature spelled the county's name CLICITAT. By the next territorial legislative session, the spelling was finalized as KCLICKITAT.
