Robert Charles Anderson. *The Great Migration: Immigrants to New England, 1634-1635*. 6 volumes to date, covering A-S. (Boston, NEHGS, 1999-).

*Colonial Records of the Swedish Churches in Pennsylvania*, Peter Stebbins Craig, editor. 5 volumes covering 1646-1759 (Philadelphia, Swedish Colonial Society, 2006-).

Frank J. Doherty. *Settlers of the Beekman Patent, Dutchess County, New York*. 10 volumes thus far covering families from Abbott to Rogers. (Pleasant Valley, N.Y., 1990-2010).

Martin E. Hollick, *New Englanders in the 1600s; a Guide to Genealogical Research published between 1980 and 2005*. (Boston, NEHGS, 2006).

Resources available on Ancestry Library edition:

Hamburg Passenger Lists, 1850-1934, aka “Hamburg Embarkation lists”. Indexed 1877-1914. Also available are the “Handwritten Indexes, 1855-1934”.

Numerous state censuses, including those for Minnesota, Iowa, Kansas, Florida, Wisconsin (1895 and 1905 only), and the recently added California 1852 state census.

Canadian censuses (1851/52-1911).

New or Practically New Online Resources:

DAR Genealogical Research System (just Google: DAR online). Indexes to the names (patriots and descendants) appearing on thousands of DAR applications.

Minnesota Marriage System. A (still partial) statewide index to Minnesota marriages.

Atlas of Historical County Boundaries. Now available online.
